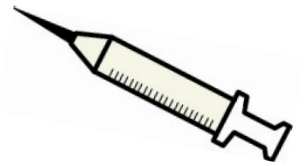


Pneumonia Shot Clinic

PROTECT OURSELVES

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends two different vaccines to prevent pneumonia - Prevnar 13 and Pneumovax 23

Administered by: Local Pharmacist and Indigo Run resident David Burke, RPh at Burke's Pharmacy

Burke's Pharmacy will bring the records for residents that had the pneumonia shot last year at the clinic. Those residents will receive the second shot Pneumovax 23.



WHO SHOULD GET A PNEUMONIA VACCINE

- All adults age 65 or older
- Adults age 19 to 64 years with a weak immune system

ONE VACCINE OR BOTH?

- Experts recommend that Prevnar 13 be given first, followed by Pneumovax 23 one year later
- Vaccines cannot be given at the same time
- **Vaccines good for 5 years**
